#### Road construction is underway

Verdae Properties has begun construction on the new road which will extend from the stoplight at the intersection of Henderson and Laurens Roads all the way down to the new Camperdown Academy. Estimated construction time is a minimum of nine months. The new road will not be used to access the Camperdown site as school construction gets underway. Temporary construction access will be available from Market Place Drive so that work on the school and road can happen at the same time.

Dedicated technology closets will make printers and laptop carts accessible to all students and teachers without classroom interruptions. Currently, laptop carts and 3-D printers are stored in classrooms. This system means the constant noise from the charging carts and printers can cause students to struggle with their concentration at times. And if a student needs a laptop for Social Studies, they have to walk through a Literature classroom to get one from the charging cart! Having dedicated spaces conveniently located in the hallways will eliminate unnecessary distractions.
