

# Camperdown Academy COVID Mitigation Strategy

## DAILY GUIDANCE

### **Temperature Checks/Health Screening**

- Daily for all staff AND students
- Any fever of 100.4 or higher will be sent home
- Hand sanitizer required for all arriving staff/students

### **Classrooms/Disinfection**

- Classrooms are rearranged to accommodate 6ft between students
- Smaller rooms are outfitted with acrylic shields to provide additional separation
- Scheduling “pods” keep Groups/Teachers in designated areas (*ie-Am Groupers and Y Groupers will not share same set of rooms or teachers*)
- High-touch areas sanitized between classes
- Electrostatic sprayer will provide quick and thorough sanitation of larger spaces
- Hand sanitizer in all classrooms
- Hand sanitizing/washing breaks will be a daily requirement
- Outdoor air ventilation rates adjusted for maximum air exchange
- No-touch trash cans will be provided in key areas throughout the school

### **Social Distancing/Masks**

- A variety of masks will be provided for all staff and students to choose from
- Students may bring their own mask/appropriate face covering from home
- Masks will be worn at all times
- Teachers may ask students to remove masks in the classroom at times when a 6 foot distance can be safely maintained
- Visual and verbal reminders of policy will prompt consistency
- Students will eat lunch/snack either outside or in classroom
- Masks can be removed when social distancing during outdoor recess

## **EXPOSURE GUIDANCE**

### **Quarantine/Exposure**

- Students and Staff will be excluded from in-person school if they have:
  - Any one (1) of the following
    - Fever -or-
    - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing -or-
    - Loss of taste or smell -or-
    - New or worsening cough
  - Any two (2) of the following
    - Sore throat
    - Muscle or body aches
    - Chills
    - Fatigue
    - Headache
    - Congestion or runny nose
    - Diarrhea
    - Nausea or vomiting
  
- Exposure *outside of* school or *at school* may result in students or staff completing a DHEC required quarantine
- DHEC guidelines will be followed for mandated quarantine and student/family notification
- Any student or staff member sent home or kept home due to exposure and/or symptoms will be required to provide a doctor's note in order to return to school
- To limit exposure, visitors to the school will be by invitation only and all large group gatherings (Child Chat, field trips, class parties, etc.) will be virtual *for now*
- Homebound (virtual instruction) will be provided to Camperdown students in quarantine

**Moving to 100% schoolwide virtual learning will be a last resort and the decision to make that move will not necessarily follow public schools but will be governed by SCISA**
