## WHAT TO EXPECT

Each tutor will conduct an informal assessment of the child's strengths and needs before the 2-week session begins.

Lessons will be taught by Associate-level OG 'tutors-in-training' under the direct and close supervision of a Master Teacher.

Students will improve skills in decoding and spelling by learning the patterns and structure of the English language using the Orton-Gillingham Approach.

A brief parent/guardian conference with the tutor will be held on July 23 to share insights and recommendations regarding student growth.

## WHAT IS REQUIRED

- A suspected diagnosis of dyslexia or a related language-based learning difference with average to above-average cognitive ability
- Commitment to attend **daily** for each of the 10 sessions
- Recommendation by a classroom teacher, reading specialist, special education teacher, or Augustine tutor as a "struggling reader"
- Submit application and teacher recommendation to be considered for the program (links below)
- \$45 fee due upon acceptance
