Thirty hours of coursework provide a variety of lectures, article readings, and hands-on exercises to promote understanding of the principles of the OG Approach and the ability to modify and provide literacy instruction for the classroom or small groups. Utilizing direct instruction, teachers will bring a multisensory, structured, sequential, phonics and language-based approach into the classroom. Access to a phonics-based literacy curriculum is encouraged for the Classroom Educator practicum.

Participants will learn how to:

- Describe how reading is acquired in all learners and the nature and needs of the dyslexic learner
- Modify and provide literacy instruction to include phonological awareness, phonics, reading fluency, vocabulary, and reading comprehension
- Explain the principles of the OG Approach and develop lesson plans for small group or whole class instruction using OG principles
- Use knowledge of the structure of the English language to build students' literacy skills

Educators interested in providing intensive remediation or working 1:1 with students should seek Associate level training.
